Orlan graduated from Southern University at New Orleans in 2004 with a Bachelor of Science in Computer Information Systems. Presently attending the University of Houston working to obtain his degree from Bauer College of Business in Executive Management Business Administration. Orlan's career started in 1993 as an Air Force Airman stationed at McChord AFB, as a network administrator. He was deployed to Desert Watch Desert Shield where he worked as a Network Engineer and Administrator in Saudi Arabia. He left active duty in 1997 and was assigned to the Louisiana Air National in New Orleans, Louisiana. While stationed at Belle Chasse Naval Air Station with the La. Air National Guard Orlan was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant through the Academy of Military Science, McGhee Tyson Air National Guard Base, Knoxville, TN. His first assignment as a new officer was to the 159<sup>th</sup> Fighter Wing as a Cyber Officer at Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Belle Chasse. In 2009 Orlan was assigned as the Officer in Charge of the electronic section of the 214<sup>th</sup> Engineering Installation Squadron. While in that position Orlan also led the new Cyber Security and Network Infrastructure programs. Orlan was promoted through the ranks, after being promoted to major he was able to put together the first Air National Guard Incident Response team and build a state-of-the-art Digital Lab used to create cyber incidents and simulate nation state threats in a controlled environment. This led to him becoming the Director of Operation for the 214EIS and leading airmen in all aspect of cyber operations.

In 2013, Orlan deployed to Bagram Air Base in Afghanistan as a Lead Engineer assigned to the 355<sup>th</sup> Army "TASK FORCE SIGNAL" supporting all DOD and civilian Network Infrastructure throughout Afghanistan. In 2014, he was awarded the Bronze Star for his role in Operation Enduring Freedom while in Afghanistan.

While in the guard in 2008 Orlan entered on duty with the FBI as a Special Agent. Orlan was assigned to the Houston Division where he worked Counterintelligence starting with global espionage and intelligence. As the cyber threats increased Orlan was moved from Counterintelligence to the Cyber Threat Squad working Eurasian Cyber intrusion. Orlan was also assigned to the joint taskforce focused on the 2016 election cyber security. After 5 years working cyber intrusions, Orlan was assigned as the FBI Houston Public Information Officer.

In January of 2019, Orlan left the FBI to develop the Cyber Threat Intelligence program for SLB (Schlumberger). SLB built a state-of-the-art Cyber Security Operations Center (CSOC) and Orlan was tasked as the Cyber Threat Intelligence officer to build out a threat intel program and incorporate it into the CSOC. Orlan led a team of analysts and supported the threat hunting team with investigating threat cases and assisting in incident response. While at SLB, Orlan was able to champion the program by adding three analysts. He was able to implement processes and automated programs to understand multiple threats and understand intelligence tools. Orlan also leads projects to develop innovative ways to detect Threat Intelligence in other environments such as end point vulnerability, mergers and acquisitions, audit section, OT/ISC and vulnerability management. Orlan's objective in the industry has always been to prioritize daily activities to decrease incidents and increase security throughout the cyber security industry.
